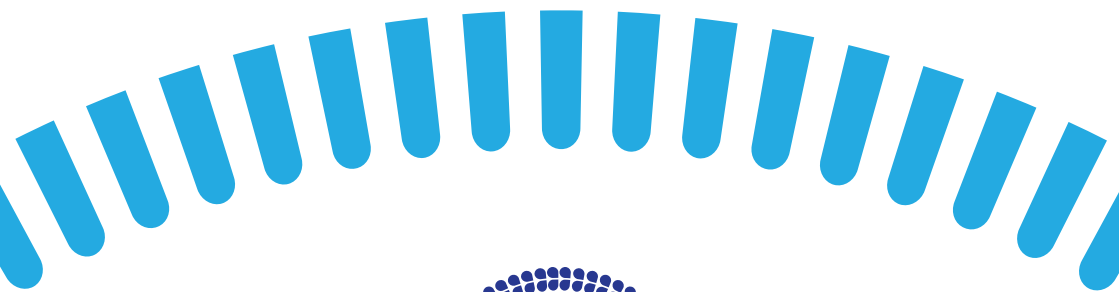

AGE GROUPS G7-G9

- Teams will play six matches against teams of the same level
- No points or league tables will be counted, and a knock-out phase will not be played
- All players will be awarded a medal for participation
- Team entry fee: €335

AGE GROUPS G10-G18

- Teams will be placed in groups of five for the group stage of the tournament
- Teams will only play against other teams of the same level
- After the group stage, the teams will be divided into A and B cup stages and the cup stages A and B will be played up to the final match
- The four best teams from the final of cup stage A will be awarded medals and the winners of the B cup final will be awarded a trophy
- The General and Entry-level finals will be played on Friday, only the Elite-level final will be played on Saturday
- Team entry fee: €350

The team level should be selected during registration, and it can be changed up until 30 April 2022. The tournament organiser reserves the right to change a team's level and to combine levels as one series if this is considered necessary.

In the age groups G10-G18 the **General and Entry-level** games start on Tuesday. The **Elite-level** games start on Wednesday.

AGE GROUPS B7-B9

- Teams will play six matches against teams of same level
- No points or league tables will be counted, and a knock-out phase will not be played
- All players will be awarded a medal for participation
- Team entry fee: €335

AGE GROUPS B10 -B17

- Teams will be placed in groups of five or six for the group stage of the tournament
- After the group stage, the teams will be divided into A, B and C finals groups
- All the finals groups will play up to the final match
- The four best teams from finals group A will be awarded medals
- The winners of finals groups A and B will be awarded a trophy
- The winner of final C will be awarded a trophy plate
- Team entry fee: €385

AGE GROUPS ENTRY-LEVEL SERIES B10H-B17H

- All entry-level series and B14, B15 and B17 are played 8v8
- Teams will be placed in groups of five or six for the group stage of the tournament
- After the group phase, teams will play a match on Thursday against a team that finished in the same position in a different group
- No other finals are played
- Team entry fee: €385

The team level should be selected during registration, and it can be changed up until 30 April 2022. The tournament organiser reserves the right to change a team's level if this is considered necessary.

REGISTRATION

- You can register for the tournament at www.helsinki.fi
- The registration period is from 15 September 2021 to 30 April 2022

RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE & OVER-AGE PLAYERS

- Participating teams must belong to an association operating under FIFA.
- School teams will be accepted from countries where school football is favoured.
- Finnish teams must be registered with the Finnish Football Association (FFA). The participating club must have teams that compete in FFA junior leagues.
- In the tournament, the FFA age limits apply. Teams can make a request to the tournament organiser for exceptional permission to include over-age players for the duration of the tournament.
- The number of individual players on a team is not limited during the tournament.

INSURANCE

The Helsinki Cup does not have insurance for players, team staff members or other people who are taking part in the tournament. International players and team staff members must have valid travel insurance or other insurance that will cover any accidents that may occur during the matches and the tournament in general.

PLAYING FIELDS

All Helsinki Cup matches will take place on high-quality natural grass and (artificial) turf fields that are in excellent condition and specifically designed for football use.
* The fields are convenient to access by public transport.





TOURNAMENT PACKAGE

The Helsinki Cup tournament package is the best way for your group to make the most of the tournament and coordinate all your tournament arrangements!

TOURNAMENT MEALS

Teams, family members and everyone else travelling with the group can enjoy nutritious tournament meals included in the tournament package for the entire Helsinki Cup week.

- Breakfast is served in the hotels/schools every morning
- Lunch and dinner are served in the tournament restaurant
- Tournament meals are available from dinner on 10 July to lunch on 16 July
- There is a vegetarian option every day

HELSINKI CUP GUIDES

Helsinki Cup guide services are available for teams that have booked the tournament package for the whole tournament week from arrival to departure.

- The guides will pick you up from the airport/harbour and take you to your accommodation
- The guides will assist you with getting from your accommodation to the playing fields, and they will help with any questions you have about the tournament or Helsinki
- The guides will be located at the hotels and schools, where they can assist you
- The guides are the link between the participating teams and the Helsinki Cup organisers
- The guides will serve teams in English or if possible in your native language

TRANSPORTATION DURING THE TOURNAMENT

A Helsinki Region Transport (HSL) travel card is included in the Helsinki Cup tournament package and entitles the holder to free use of HSL public transport for the entire tournament week.

- The card can be used for free travel during the tournament in the Helsinki area (and to some extent, Espoo and Vantaa), including the Suomenlinna ferry
- All tournament playing fields are located within a convenient distance by public transport
- Teams can also book transport to their hotel from Helsinki-Vantaa airport, the Helsinki harbours, the bus station and the railway station to the hotel by contacting the Helsinki Cup sales team
- We recommend using the comprehensive public transport system due to a lack of parking spaces in the city



ACCOMMODATION

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

The Helsinki Cup offers quality hotel accommodation through its partners at Holiday Inn and Scandic hotels.

- All the hotels are located close to Helsinki city centre and are in the immediate vicinity of the playing fields.
- Accommodation is available in rooms for 1 to 4 guests, including amenities.
- All the hotel packages include a full Scandinavian buffet breakfast each morning (lunch and dinner are served at the tournament restaurant).
- Family members and everyone else travelling with the group are just as welcome to stay at Helsinki Cup's partner hotels at the same tournament rates as the teams. Please note that accommodation with breakfast only is also available at a discounted price.

SCHOOL ACCOMMODATION

The Helsinki Cup tournament package is also available with dormitory-style school accommodation.

- School accommodation is available for players and team staff only. Most teams will be placed in classrooms, with a maximum capacity of 18 people per room.
- The school package includes 18 meals: 6 breakfasts (at the school), 6 lunches and 6 dinners (at the tournament restaurant).
- Teams can rent or buy mattresses and bedlinen from the tournament organiser.

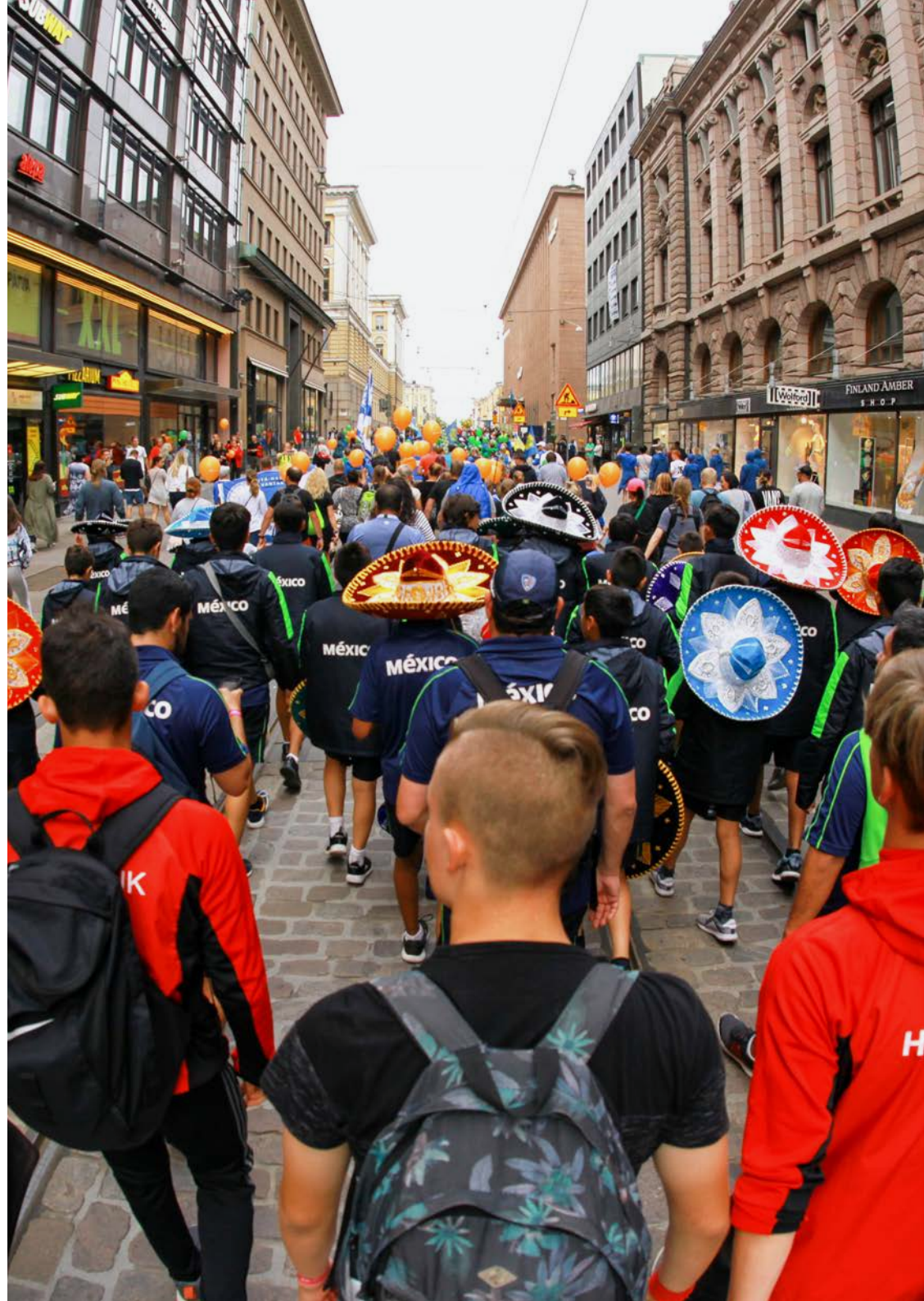
HELSINKI CUP DISCO

BY FERRY

There are daily ferry services to Helsinki from Estonia, Sweden and Germany. All the ferry companies offer the option of taking a car with you. Helsinki can also be reached by ferry from Russia and Poland.

BY PLANE

Helsinki can be reached easily from anywhere in the world.

Helsinki Airport serves around 200 international flights every day. Finnair's route network covers over 1,000 destinations in 150 countries worldwide and the airline, together with its partner airlines, operates direct flights from Helsinki to North America and Asia. Finnair also flies to over 40 cities in Europe. The trip from the airport to the city only takes around 30 minutes.
